“What a blessing.”

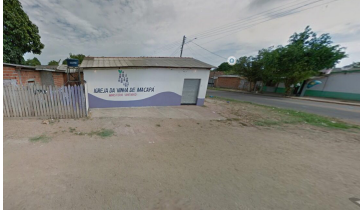
The demolition of the old structure became more than a construction moment. It became a symbol of transition.
